



Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Can FIREBALL be played on any bet type?**
Yes, FIREBALL can be added to any available bet type in Pick-3 or Pick-4 for the same price as the play.
- 2. So players can add FIREBALL on a Close Enough bet type?**
No, Close Enough will no longer be available as a bet type on either Pick-3 or Pick-4. The last day to purchase Close Enough is February 19, 2017. More details can be found at njlottery.com.
- 3. Can players win on both the base game and FIREBALL?**
Yes, FIREBALL prizes are awarded in addition to the base game prizes.
- 4. Do FIREBALL prizes differ from base game prizes?**
Yes, please see the prize structures for the average prizes.
- 5. Will FIREBALL apply to both midday and evening drawings?**
Yes, players can add FIREBALL for both midday and evening drawings.
- 6. Will players still be able to add Instant Match to Pick-3 or Pick-4?**
Yes, players will still be able to play Instant Match for an additional \$1 per play. They can add Instant Match and FIREBALL on the same play for a minimum total cost of \$2.00.
- 7. Is the FIREBALL number different for Pick-3 and Pick-4?**
No, the Lottery will draw one FIREBALL number that will apply to both Pick-3 and Pick-4.
- 8. Can players still use old play slips to purchase a Pick-3 or Pick-4 ticket?**
No, starting February 27, the old Pick-3 and Pick-4 play slips will no longer be able to be used. Players should use the new Pick-3 or Pick-4 play slip that includes FIREBALL. Remind players to ask for a new Pick-3 or Pick-4 play slip at retail.
- 9. Can a Pick-3 or Pick-4 ticket be canceled if it includes FIREBALL?**
Yes, Pick-3 and Pick-4 including FIREBALL can be canceled. Pick-3 and Pick-4 tickets that include Instant Match cannot.
