One Jersey Cash 5 Ticket Wins \$536,948 Jackpot in Gloucester County

TRENTON (Aug. 17, 2017) – One lucky ticket matched all five numbers drawn winning the \$536,948 Jersey Cash 5 jackpot from the Wednesday, Aug. 16 drawing. The winning numbers were: 07, 11, 15, 21 and 27 and the XTRA number was: 03. The lucky retailer that sold the winning ticket is Quick Shop, 4701 Route 42, Turnersville in Gloucester County.

Executive Director Carole Hedinger said, "We are thrilled that the winning jackpot ticket was sold at Quick Shop. The retailer will receive a bonus check for \$2,000 for selling the winning ticket. Overnight, they have become one more 'lucky location' for the very fortunate lottery winner."

Executive Director Carole Hedinger announced that there were 564,287 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four of the five numbers drawn, 168 ticketholders won \$296 each and 20 others won \$888 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three of the five numbers drawn, 4,976 ticketholders won \$10 each and 699 others won \$30 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 7,046 ticketholders each won \$2 for correctly matching two of the five numbers drawn with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
