\$6.2 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$6.2 Million for Jan. 8 Drawing

TRENTON (Jan. 5, 2018) – Although there was no top prize winner for the Thursday, Jan. 4 Pick-6 game drawing, there were eight ticketholders who won \$2,718 for matching five out of the six white balls drawn. Two of those tickets were purchased with the addition of XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$10,872. In addition, thousands of other prizewinning tickets were sold.

The winning numbers for the Thursday, Jan. 4 drawing were: 06, 17, 26, 35, 38 and 41. The XTRA Multiplier was: 04. The jackpot for the Pick-6 XTRA game has rolled to \$6.2 million. The next drawing will be held Monday, Jan. 8.

Acting Executive Director John M. White announced that there were 434,902 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four numbers, 324 ticketholders won \$65 each and 41 others won \$260 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers 6,156 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 730 others won \$12 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 5,993 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
