## \$2.4 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$2.4 Million for March 5<sup>th</sup> Drawing

**TRENTON (March 2, 2018)** – Pick-6 XTRA's jackpot has rolled to \$2.4 million! **March 1**<sup>st</sup> drawing produced **nine winners** of **\$2,490** all of whom matched five out of six white balls drawn. Two of those tickets were purchased with XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$4,980. Acting Executive Director John M. White announced that there were 448,294 tickets purchased for the drawing and of those sold, thousands were prizewinners! The next drawing will be held Monday, March 05, 2018.

The winning numbers for the Thursday, March 1<sup>st</sup> drawing were: **06, 09, 10, 37, 42 and 49**. The XTRA Multiplier was: **02**. By adding XTRA for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn.

For correctly matching four numbers, 315 ticketholders won \$68 each and 45 others won \$136 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers 6,583 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 846 others won \$6 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 7,301 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.

All New Jersey Lottery game winning numbers and drawings for the Pick-3, Pick-4, Jersey Cash 5, Pick-6, CASH4LIFE and 5 Card Cash games can be viewed on the NJ Lottery website (www.NJLottery.com) or on the official Lottery Facebook Page. Midday and evening draws, with the exception of CASH4LIFE and 5 Card Cash, can be seen on WPIX-TV (PIX11) in New York and WPHL-TV (PHL17) in Philadelphia. Powerball and Mega Millions drawings can be seen on WABC-TV or WTXF stations.
