## \$4 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$4 Million for April 23 Drawing

**TRENTON (April 20, 2018)** – Pick-6 XTRA's jackpot has rolled to \$4 million! **April 23**<sup>rd'</sup>s **drawing** produced **eleven winners** of **\$2,148** all of whom matched five out of six white balls drawn. If those tickets had been purchased with XTRA, it would have multiplied the prize to \$4,296. Acting Executive Director John M. White announced that there were 472,733 tickets purchased for the drawing and of those sold, thousands were prizewinners! The next drawing will be held Monday, April 23, 2018.

The winning numbers for the Thursday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> drawing were: **02**, **10**, **20**, **33**, **39** and **49**. The XTRA Multiplier was: **02**. By adding XTRA for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn.

For correctly matching four numbers, 301 ticketholders won \$73 each and 51 others won \$146 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers 6,415 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 838 others won \$6 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 7,280 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.

All New Jersey Lottery game winning numbers and drawings for the Pick-3, Pick-4, Jersey Cash 5, Pick-6, CASH4LIFE and 5 Card Cash games can be viewed on the NJ Lottery website (www.NJLottery.com) or on the official Lottery Facebook Page. Midday and evening draws, with the exception of CASH4LIFE and 5 Card Cash, can be seen on WPIX-TV (PIX11) in New York and WPHL-TV (PHL17) in Philadelphia. Powerball and Mega Millions drawings can be seen on WABC-TV or WTXF stations.
