## \$4.8 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$4.8 Million for May 3 Drawing

**TRENTON (May 1, 2018)** – Pick-6 XTRA's jackpot has rolled to \$4.8 million! **April 30**<sup>th</sup>'s drawing produced two winners of **\$12,599** all of whom matched five out of six white balls drawn. One of those tickets was purchased with XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$37,797. Acting Executive Director John M. White announced that there were 503,998 tickets purchased for the drawing and of those sold, thousands were prizewinners! The next drawing will be held Thursday, May 3, 2018.

The **winning numbers** for the **Monday, April 30<sup>th</sup>** drawing were: **13, 14, 17, 26, 35 and 48**. The XTRA **Multiplier** was: **03**. By adding XTRA for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn.

For correctly matching four numbers, 375 ticketholders won \$64 each and 55 others won \$192 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers 7,188 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 961 others won \$9 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly 7,696 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.

All New Jersey Lottery game winning numbers and drawings for the Pick-3, Pick-4, Jersey Cash 5, Pick-6, CASH4LIFE and 5 Card Cash games can be viewed on the NJ Lottery website (www.NJLottery.com) or on the official Lottery Facebook Page. Midday and evening draws, with the exception of CASH4LIFE and 5 Card Cash, can be seen on WPIX-TV (PIX11) in New York and WPHL-TV (PHL17) in Philadelphia. Powerball and Mega Millions drawings can be seen on WABC-TV or WTXF stations.
