New Jersey Lottery Ticket Hits \$315.3 Million Powerball Jackpot

Two New Jersey Lottery Tickets Won \$150,000 and Four Tickets Won \$50,000

TRENTON (May 21, 2018) – New Jersey Lottery Acting Executive Director John M. White announced that the **only Powerball jackpot winning ticket** from the **Saturday, May 19** drawing was sold in New Jersey. The winning ticket was sold at **Shoprite of Hackensack, 500 South River St., Hackensack in Bergen County**.

In addition, there were six New Jersey Lottery tickets sold that matched four of the five white balls and the Powerball drawn for the **Saturday**, **May 19** drawing winning the \$50,000 third-tier prize. Two of those tickets were purchased with Power Play multiplying the prizes to \$150,000. The winning tickets from Saturday night's drawing were sold at the following locations:

- Middlesex County (\$150,000): Quick Convenience, 2625 Woodbridge Ave., Edison;
- Somerset County (\$150,000): Speedy Mart, 17 Johnson Dr., Watchung;
- Bergen County (\$50,000): CBR Lodi LLC/BP, 179 US Highway 46, Lodi;
- Bergen County (\$50,000): Mini Mart, 300 Park Ave., Rutherford;
- Camden County (\$50,000): 7-Eleven #36707, 82 Route 73, Voorhees; and
- Morris County (\$50,000): Acme #1077, 123 East Main St., Denville.

The winning numbers for the Saturday, May 19 drawing were: 03, 06, 09, 17 and 56. The Red Power Ball number was 25. The Multiplier number was 03. The Powerball jackpot reset to \$40,000,000 for the next drawing to be held Wednesday, May 23 at 10:59 pm.

In addition to the third-tier prizewinning tickets sold, there were 51,085 New Jersey players who took home an estimated \$290,878 in prizes ranging from \$4 to \$300, according to Lottery Acting Executive Director John M. White.

"Congratulations to all of the lottery players who purchased winning tickets and to the retailers that sold them," said White. "I'd like to remind players to purchase their Powerball tickets with a winning attitude and add Power Play to the ticket purchase. Power Play doubles the second prize from one million dollars to two million dollars and multiplies all of the seven lower prize sets available in the game by the number drawn that evening. The jackpot prize is not multiplied."
