## \$12.5 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$12.5 Million for Aug. 2<sup>nd</sup> Drawing

**TRENTON (July 31, 2018)** – Pick-6 XTRA's jackpot has rolled to \$12.5 million! **July 30<sup>th</sup>'s drawing** produced **15 winners** of **\$2,492** all of whom matched five out of six white balls drawn. Five of those tickets were purchased with XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$7,476 each. Acting Executive Director James Carey announced that there were 747,684 tickets purchased for the drawing and of those sold, thousands were prizewinners! The next drawing will be held Thursday, August 2, 2018.

The winning numbers for the Monday, July 30<sup>th</sup> drawing were: 08, 14, 21, 22, 40, and 48. The XTRA Multiplier was: 03. By adding XTRA for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn.

For correctly matching four numbers, 590 ticketholders won \$60 each and 94 others won \$180 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers 10,980 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 1,307 others won \$9 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly 11,123 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.

All New Jersey Lottery game winning numbers and drawings for the Pick-3, Pick-4, Jersey Cash 5, Pick-6, CASH4LIFE and 5 Card Cash games can be viewed on the NJ Lottery website (www.NJLottery.com) or on the official Lottery Facebook Page. Evening draws, with the exception of CASH4LIFE and 5 Card Cash, can be seen on WPIX-TV (PIX11) in New York and WPHL-TV (PHL17) in Philadelphia.
