## \$15.2 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$15.2 Million for Aug. 30<sup>th</sup> Drawing

**TRENTON** (Aug. 28, 2018) — Pick-6 XTRA's jackpot has rolled to \$15.2 million! Aug. 27<sup>th</sup>'s drawing produced 10 winners of \$3,960 all of whom matched five out of six white balls drawn. Three of those tickets were purchased with XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$11,880. Acting Executive Director James Carey announced that there were 792,097 tickets purchased for the drawing and of those sold, thousands were prizewinners! The next drawing will be held Thursday, August 30, 2018.

The winning numbers for the Monday, Aug. 27<sup>th</sup> drawing were: 06, 16, 21, 38, 44, and 45. The XTRA Multiplier was: 03. By adding XTRA for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn.

For correctly matching four numbers, 589 ticketholders won \$65 each and 78 others won \$195 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers 11,096 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 1,378 others won \$9 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly 10,992 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.

All New Jersey Lottery game winning numbers and drawings for the Pick-3, Pick-4, Jersey Cash 5, Pick-6, CASH4LIFE and 5 Card Cash games can be viewed on the NJ Lottery website (www.NJLottery.com) or on the official Lottery Facebook Page.
