Jersey Cash Jackpot Now At \$396,000 Get Your Tickets and Get in the Game

TRENTON (Aug. 30, 2018) – The Jersey Cash 5 game is "on a roll," making the jackpot for tonight's drawing \$396,000! So, get ready New Jersey Lottery players and buy your ticket for tonight's drawing for a chance to "win big" if your ticket matches the numbers drawn.

In fact, on Friday, August 24th, three lucky players shared a \$183,408 jackpot. The drawings on Saturday and Sunday, produced a \$100,000 winner each night. WELL, IT COULD HAPPEN **AGAIN!** *Get in this game; the next Jersey Cash 5 jackpot winner could be you. Remember, anything can happen in Jersey.*

A Jersey Cash 5 ticket cost just \$1.00 per play; by adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per ticket, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn.

Carey announced that 7,446 Lottery players won a total of \$92,444 in prized in last night's drawing. For correctly matching four of the five numbers drawn, 53 ticketholders won \$573 each and 9 others won \$1,146 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three of the five numbers drawn, 2,119 ticketholders won \$15 each and 364 others won \$30 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly 4,528 ticketholders each won \$2 for correctly matching two of the five numbers drawn with the addition of XTRA on their purchase. The winning numbers for the Tuesday, August 29th drawing were: 09, 23, 28, 30, and 41. The XTRA number was 2.
