Four \$10,000 Winning Tickets Sold Mega Millions Rolls to \$275 Million

TRENTON (Sept. 19, 2018) – James Carey, New Jersey Lottery acting executive director, announced that there were **four third-tier prizewinning tickets** sold for the Tuesday, Sept, 18 drawing that matched four of the five white balls and the Gold Mega Ball drawn winning the **\$10,000** prize. Those tickets were purchased at the following locations:

- Hudson County: Vicky 22, 111 14th St., Hoboken;
- Morris County: Speedway #3463, 60 Route 46 E., Mountain Lakes;
- Somerset County: Shop Rite, 435 Elizabeth Ave., Somerset; and
- Union County: 7-Eleven #24107, 317 Morris Ave., Summit.

If those tickets had been purchased with the Megaplier option, the prizes would be multiplied to \$20,000. The winning numbers for the Tuesday, Sept. 18 drawing were: 31, 32, 43, 63 and 68. The Gold Mega Ball was 17, and the Megaplier Multiplier was 02.

In addition, 20 other players matched four of the five white balls drawn making each ticket worth \$500. Two of those tickets were purchased with the Megaplier option, multiplying the prize to \$1,000. Moreover, 35,128 other New Jersey players took home \$130,652 in prizes ranging from \$2 to \$400, according to Carey.

"Congratulations to the lottery winners and to the retailers that sold the winning tickets," said Carey. "For selling the winning tickets, the retailers have become many more Lottery 'lucky locations' overnight."

The next drawing will be held Friday, Sept. 21 at 11:00 pm. All New Jersey Lottery Mega Millions tickets must be purchased before 10:45 pm to participate in the drawing. Mega Millions tickets cost just two dollars; by adding the Megaplier option for an extra dollar per play, players can increase their non-jackpot winnings up to five times. Mega Millions tickets are sold in 46 participating jurisdictions. Drawings are held on Tuesdays and Fridays.
